Catholic Charities Diocese of Nashville is seeking candidates for one full time Program Specialist in the area of Substance Abuse/Mental Health in our County Expansion/Tennessee Serves Neighbors Program. This program is funded through the Tennessee Department of Human Services from a surplus of TANF dollars. The position will be based in and will cover Maury County. This is a full-time position, working 37.5 hours per week from 8:00am-4:30pm Monday through Friday, with some flexibility required.

This position will provide office-based therapy and support services to low-income clients and families. The primary function of this position will be providing trauma informed individual, group, and family counseling by formulating and implementing treatment plans for each client.
